Website traffic stalled and started decreasing after a while.




It had a niche 4k+ articles.

Point of view (expertise)

Some professionals advised creating more content and linking it to their topic cluster strategy (still not very well defined).

I knew the problem could be solved in a different way.

They needed to be seen.

My take on this issue



What I did:


- Changes in the slug URL from numbers to readable text
- Updated robots.txt to block only private content
- Updated sitemap with a correct structure, and hierarchy and page update timeframes
- Re-indexing in Google Search Console (took me a month)
- Updated metadescription for the 200 most visited
- Updated anchor links
- Updated internal links with a better structure
- ALT text to 200 most visited articles images

no content refreshing at all at this point.




The results

- Same amount of clicks of 2022 in 50 days
- Doubled the CTR
- Half the impressions of 2022 in 50 days



Discover ressurection


CTR went up almost 3x comparing to 2022
